

Dear Parents,

Each year, the 5th and 6th grade classes participate in an Outdoor Education Program. This coming year's program will be held at Black Lake Camp in Olympia, on **May 26 – 28, 2010**. Students will leave school in the CKA vans on Wednesday morning and return Friday afternoon.

This 3 day, overnight camp is a **required** part of Christ the King Academy's 5th and 6th grade curriculum. The program is designed to increase the student's awareness of God's love through a better understanding of His Creation. Natural science and environmental education topics are taught from a Christian perspective. Subjects included are in the disciplines of biology, geology, botany, ecology, conservation, nature study, and outdoor recreation skills. Classes are taught by Black Lake Camps staff members.

The cost for this program is \$200 per student. A \$20 fee is due each month, August – May, in addition to your tuition.
