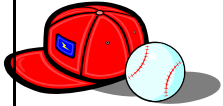


## JUNIOR HIGH LAST WEEK SCHEDULE

# CKA FIELD DAY

## What events make up field day?

## How are teams determined?

The entire student body participates and is divided into teams. Each team has a "coach" who is one of the teachers. Each team is made up of K – 8<sup>th</sup> graders. **Parent volunteers** are needed to help at the different event stations.

## What do the coaches do?

Each teacher supervises their team, promotes team spirit, and makes sure the team is at the right event at the right time.

## What about scoring?

We have a scoring table where tallies of the events are sent by each coach. Volunteers keep scores and post team results so the participants can see how they are doing.

## What about awards?

All participants will receive a special award. All in all, it is a fun time had by all. You are welcome to come and watch or take pictures of your kids.

## What happens when the games are over?

Students will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m. Parents **MUST** pick up their child from their **homeroom class**. All students must be picked up by 11:30 a.m.
