

JUNIOR HIGH GUIDELINES

Paper headings will be headed on the right side of the paper. List in the following order: name, subject, assignment, date.

All math is to be done in pencil. All work is to be shown to receive full credit. Use red pen when correcting.

All work is to be written in complete sentences. Work turned in needs to be in pencil, blue, or black ink.

If you are absent all make-up work is to be completed in a two-day time frame. Example- 1 day absent= 2 days to make up work.

Late assignments: All work is due on the stated upon due date by your child's teacher. Work turned in one day late will receive a lowered grade. Work later than one day will receive a zero for that assignment.

Lockers: Bring a combination lock from home. The combination must be given to your homeroom teacher before the lock can be used. Lockers must be locked at all times.

Graffiti: No inappropriate writing on notebooks, books, jeans, backpacks or skin. No defacing of another student's property will be allowed.

Tardiness: every 3 unexcused tardies, per class, per quarter, will result in your grade being lowered 1%. Parents will be notified at 2 tardies.

Gum: There is to be no gum chewing in the building or on the play ground during regular school hours or school events.

Snack Break: a snack break in the morning is up to your 3rd period teacher.

Inappropriate behaviors will result in a verbal warning. If behavior continues, you will be removed from the classroom, for a private discussion with the teacher, and your parents will be called that evening.

Electronics: no cell phones, iPods or any electronic devices are to be out during the school day or after school. You must be completely off campus. First time offense, parents will have to pick up your property in the office. Second offense, your property will be in the office for a week.

Hallways/Lockers: All books and personal items must be kept in your locker. Nothing should be left on the floors. Backpacks are to be kept in your locker.

Bathroom Use: Trips to the restroom should be limited to your 5-minute break between classes.

Vocabulary: Students are not to use inappropriate language. The words stupid and shut-up are not to be used at all.

Organization: Students are expected to bring all items needed for the class period. You will be charged 25 cents to visit your locker during class time.

Planners: Planners are graded weekly on a 10 point basis. This will be included in your Bible grade to teach you to be good stewards of your time.
