EMERGENCY READINESS INFORMATION

In order to better prepare our teachers to care for your child in the event of an earthquake or other disaster situation, we ask that every child have an *EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT* at school. Each kit will fit in a large Ziploc bag. Kits are kept in plastic containers located in the outside storage shed. You will be asked to update items, as needed, each new school year.

YOUR CHILD'S ZIPLOC BAG SHOULD CONTAIN:

- NAME OF STUDENT
- FAMILY PICTURE
- NOTE OF ENCOURAGEMENT FROM HOME
- 2 MINI CANS OR SMALL BOXES OR POUCHES OF JUICE
- 1 SMALL CAN (7-8 OZ.) OF SOUP OR SOUP LIKE ITEM WITH A PULL TOP LID
- 1 SMALL BOX OF BREAKFAST CEREAL (SINGLE SERVING)
- 1 SMALL (4-5 OZ) CONTAINER OF PUDDING
- 1 GRANOLA BAR
- 1 CANDY BAR
- 3 PLASTIC SPOONS
- 1 LARGE PLASTIC TRASH BAG
- 1 SPACE BLANKET (THE TYPE THAT FOLDS COMPACTLY)

Medication for asthma, seizures, A.D.D. (or any other), that is required on a regular basis should be clearly marked and placed in the kit.

Please stick to the items on this list because storage is limited.
